All high point awards will be calculated as per rule 45 of the AQHA rulebook.
If a tie still exists after enacting rule 45g, then the tie break order will be Western Pleasure, HUS, Trail. For led high points the tie break order will be lungeline, led trail, hunter in hand. For the EWD high point the tie break order will be western horsemanship, HSE, Trail.

If an amateur or youth is exhibiting more than two horses they will need to nominate their two horses to be counted towards the high point awards prior to the commencement of the show with the show office. If they fail to nominate their two horses then the first two horses they compete on will be counted towards the high point calculations.

NPHA RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All owners and handler/riders of horses competing in this show are required to be current financial members of the Australian Quarter Horse Association or an AQHA affiliate otherwise they will be required to pay a temporary membership. Owners and handlers/riders of horses competing in the feature events are required to be current financial members of the NPHA.
- No change of rider is allowed without advising the show office at least one hour prior to the event taking place.
- In the case of any dishonoured payments the exhibitor will be contacted and new payment must be made within 5 working days and a dishonour fee of \$20 will apply. If restitution is not made within this time frame the entries will not be accepted.
- Any owner/competitor with funds owing to NPHA will not be allowed to show at subsequent shows.
- Late entries for all events will be accepted up until 2pm on the day prior to commencement of the class and will incur a late fee.
- No refund of entry fees will be made after the 6th of May 2022, except in the event of the death of a horse.
- All open and amateur classes with an entry fee of \$55 will have prize money paid out on a jackpot basis which will be the pool of entry fees less GST and fees for the total horses competing in the event less 40%. This money will be paid out on the following basis, 1st 40%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20% and 4th 10%. Some of these classes have a mandatory minimum amount of prize money which will be paid out regardless of the number of entries received.
- Prize money is not applicable to all classes with a \$35 entry fee.
- NPHA reserves the right to amend advertised prize money on feature classes to a jackpot system.
- NPHA high point awards are calculated as per AQHA rules using only the AA Plaque judges placings. In the event of a tie being unable to be broken using the AQHA rules then the tie break event order will be Western Pleasure, Hunter Under Saddle, Trail. In led events the tie break order will be lungeline, Hunter In Hand, Led Trail.
- In the case of outbreak of any contagious or infectious disease amongst horses, neither the NPHA nor the sponsors of show organisers will be liable for any damage or loss that may occur to any person or animal.

- Dogs are welcome at SIEC but must be kept on a leash at all times. No dogs are allowed anywhere in or near the indoor arena.
- All motorised vehicles are to adhere to RTA legislation. Quad bikes are not allowed on the grounds. No vehicles except for emergency or medical vehicles are to drive into the stable areas. No pushbikes, skateboards etc are to be ridden within the stable block or the arenas. Golf Buggies are not to be taken inside the stable area.
- No horses are to be lunged in the indoor arena or any of the outdoor arenas except for the designated times that Lungeline competitors are given to practice in the indoor arena. All lunging is to be done in the round yards.
- No horses are to be left in the round yards. These yards are for lunging only.
- Drug testing may be done at this show. Please refer to Section 1 2.8 – 2.11 of the AQHA Official Handbook for further rules relating to Drugs and Surgical Procedures. All horses are subject to drug testing and all owners agree that by making their entry, they will submit their horses to be drug tested if/when requested.
- If a horse returns a positive random drug test, all prize money must be returned to NPHA with a \$3,000 fine for the rider/handler and the horse owner within 14 days of notification. Competitors/Owners will not be eligible to compete in future NPHA shows until the fine is paid in full.
- Competitors realise that horse related competition has an inherent risk and as such compete at this competition at their own risk. The NPHA and show organisers will accept no liability for accident, loss or injury. This applies to all competitors, their connections, horses and spectators.
- All buildings are NO SMOKING ZONES so please observe this ruling.
- A stable deposit of \$87.00 is required on all stables/tack rooms. If you wish to receive your deposit back, then you must totally clean out your stable, including being swept, and have it inspected and locked prior to your departure from the venue.
- No lunging or exercising of horses is permitted on the SIEC lawns.
- First aid officers are available on the grounds during the show hours.
- Every horse entered for competition shall be under the control of the Show Manager or such person/s he appoints to act on his behalf.
- Only contestants in the specific classes and show officials will be allowed in the competition arena or marshalling area during the judging.
- The Show Manager or such person he appoints shall have discretion to eject any exhibitor from the said area for inhumane treatment and/or training of any horse or failure to observe the Rules and Regulations of the competition and the Rules and Regulations of the AQHA or any reasonable request. Your co-operation is expected.

- Show management may exclude horses from competition should there be any unnecessary or embarrassing delay on the part of the exhibitor in bringing the horse into the competition arena. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to present themselves at the competition arena gate when called. Failure to report on final call will result in disqualification from the class. In the event that a horse is excluded from entry, all entry fees and charges for the class are forfeited without liability to the show organisers/committee.
- Show management reserve the right to change the order of classes before or during the show. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be aware of any changes which will be posted at the Show Secretary's office and announced. Every endeavour will be made to give one hour's notice of any changes to the running order of events; however, every will be made to avoid changes.
- Any exhibitor or rider who refuses to obey the request of the Judge, Show Manager or any show official will be automatically disqualified from further competition at the show and forfeits all previous winnings together with all entry fees and other charges. At the discretion of the Show Manager or show committee, the offending individual and his/her entire exhibit may be removed from the grounds.
- All horses must be serviceably sound. In case of suspected unsoundness the Judge and/or Show Management may, if he/she so desires have the animal examined by the Show Veterinarian and his decision shall be final.
- Riders and handlers must be correctly attired at all times including western hat/helmet and riding boots. Any person not correctly attired will not be allowed into the Marshalling arenas or show arenas.
- The disputes committee shall consist of the Show Manager, one show committee member and one competitor.
- Protests must be made in writing to the show secretary and be lodged within 30 minutes of the completion of the disputed event. A cash fee of \$50 must accompany any protest.
- Youth ages will be as at 1st August, 2020, and all youth competitors must have the written permission of a parent or guardian or legal guardian to compete.
- If a horse is vetted out, and it has been entered for competition in a youth event, then that youth can use a replacement horse as long as the replacement horse has been previously entered in the show. It should be noted that once this has taken place the horse that was vetted out is not allowed to compete in the rest of the show in any classes.
- In an amateur class, if the amateurs horse is vetted out they will be permitted to use a replacement horse for that class as long as the replacement horse has been previously entered in the show. The replacement horse must be eligible according to the AQHA amateur rules. It should be noted that once this has taken place the horse that was vetted out is not allowed to compete in the rest of the show in any classes.

- Youth competitors can nominate a maximum of only two horses that will count towards their High Point awards. If the youth fails to nominate two horses then the first two horses that they competed on will be used in the high point calculations.
- One rider is allowed to show two or more horses in the Open feature events only (excludes Limited, Youth, Amateur, Amateur Limited, 3YO & Under Non Pro and Select Amateur). If more than one horse finals then a substitute rider must be used as long as the rider that qualified both horses for these events rides one of the horses. The original rider of this horse is to advise the show office of the substitute rider's name.
- Open Limited-Riders are ineligible to compete in open limited classes when they have earned more than \$5000 in Western Pleasure and \$2500 in HUS at NPHA shows ONLY. Please refer to Limited Rider Ineligible list on the NPHA website.
- Amateur Limited-Riders are ineligible to compete in amateur limited classes when they have earned 15 or more points in amateur/select amateur/limited amateur classes and feature events in that relevant event at NPHA shows ONLY and/or have won the NPHA Amateur Western Pleasure Stakes on or after 2011. Please refer to Amateur Limited Ineligible list on the NPHA website.
- Competitors/participants of any event run by the NPHA have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealing with the affiliate and other competitors. To uphold the rules and regulations of the NPHA and the AQHA at all times. Competitors/participants are to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times, showing respect for your fellow competitors and officials, following the rules and to treat people the way you wish to be treated.
- Maiden Horses must not have been shown under saddle prior to the maiden Horse Western Pleasure feature event. If Horse is found to have been shown under saddle will be disqualified and forfeit all entry fees and be required to return all/any prize monies awarded for the event.
- Novice Horse classes as per AQHA, AAA rules may not have more than 20 points and PHAA rules no more than 10 points in their respective class. Competitors are responsible to know how many points their horses have earned prior to competition regardless of what has been posted on association web pages. Point totals will be checked with the horse's respective breed society prior to the event, and if disqualified, entrants will forfeit their entry fees. Entrants are responsible to ensure their eligibility and a decision by Show management on eligibility is final.

- All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event, must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant and in the case of a contestant, the parent/guardian must also sign the entry form. All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth is in attendance at that event.
- No alcohol is allowed in or can be consumed in the marshalling areas, working arenas or show pen/contest areas.
- In the event of a covid outbreak OR natural disaster resulting in cancellation of the event before it commences, NPHA will refund less office fee & processing fee to cover costs incurred due to cancellation.
- REFUND POLICY
 - If the show is cancelled prior to commencing, a full refund will be given excluding the office fee and processing fee.
 - Postponed shows or shows cancelled after the commencement of the show due to Covid - 19/Natural Disaster will require the competitor to contact the show secretary to determine when they will receive a refund of entries. A % of entries may be kept to cover the costs that the show has already incurred.
 - NOMINATION refunds – No refunds will be given after the closing date of the entries UNLESS accompanied by a Veterinary Certificate/Medical Certificate.
 - NOTE: NO refund will be received until the certificate/s have been received by the Show Secretary no less than 7 days after the cessation of the show. Refunds exclude the Office Fee & credit card charges.
